

Bath and former England rugby player Danny Grewcock and former Arsenal and Scotland goalkeeper Bob Wilson were joined last month by guests, including Paul White of Frogmore and Greg Nicholson of CB Richard Ellis, for the third annual Willow Foundation Shooting Day at the Royal Berkshire Shooting School.

More than 100 people, many from the property industry, attended the 2010 event, which involved shooting simulated pheasants. Guests then enjoyed a champagne reception, lunch and a charity auction held by Duncan Moir of Allsop.

The event raised more than £30,000 for the Willow Foundation, a national charity which provides special days for seriously ill 16- to 40-year-olds across the UK.

To date, the Willow Foundation has provided almost 6,000 days out for people living with cancer, cystic fibrosis, motor neurone disease, muscular dystrophy, organ failure, Huntington's and other conditions.
