Frogmore has a ball for Willow Foundation

Industry luminaries raised a remarkable £254,000 in one evening at a ball to celebrate the 50th anniversary of property company Frogmore on 14 April.

The event at London's Park Plaza Riverbank hotel was attended by 500 people, and raised money for the Willow Foundation.

The charity was founded by former Arsenal and Scotland goalkeeper Bob Wilson and his wife, Megs, in memory of their daughter Anna, who died aged 31. The Willow Foundation organises special days for seriously ill people aged between 16 and 40.
