Twisted two complete tower deal

A partnership between Frogmore and Galliard Homes has completed the purchase of Ballymore's "twisted" tower in London's Docklands.

Property Week first wrote in November (news, 30.11.12) that a partnership between two of London's most experienced developers, Galliard's Stephen Conway and

Frogmore's Paul White, was planning to buy the site for £30m.

The 46-storey residential tower will contain 330 flats priced between £300,000 and £1m. A 28-storey hotel and a 17-storey building containing affordable housing, leisure and retail space will also be developed on the site.
