HOUSING crisis? What housing crisis? Last night the Chilterns, a luxury apartment complex being built on Chiltern Street, was launched at One Marylebone. The cheapest flat in the building, due for completion in 2015, will set you back £3 million, with access to a communal cinema, optional wine cellar and a David Bailey photograph as part of the bargain.
